If you drive as far north as you can travel on Ontario's Provincial Highway System, you will find yourself at the ferry dock in Cochenour;

Red Lake is the Norseman Floatplane capital of the world;

There have been two Hudson's Bay Posts in the area:

one from 1825 to 1925 at Post Narrows, and
one from 1925 to 1933 at Johnson's Point.

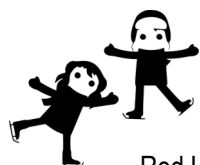

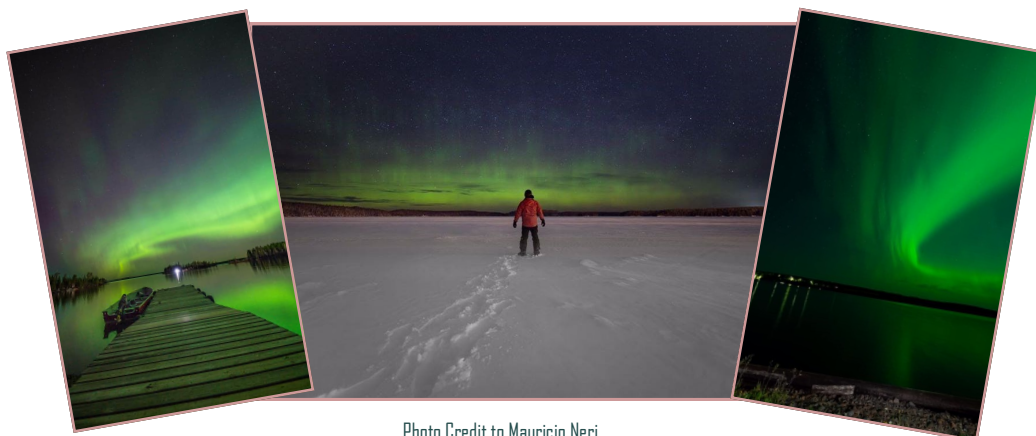
