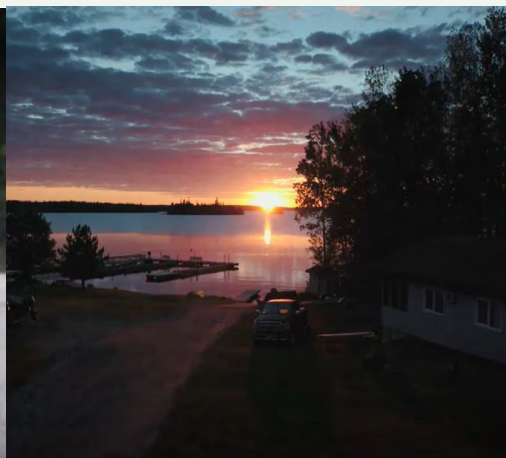
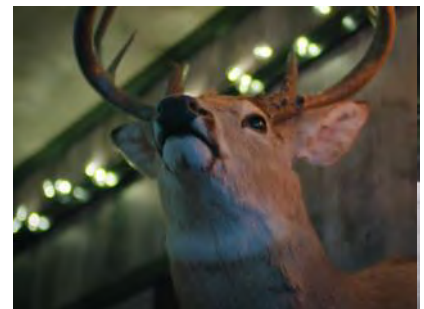

The Lac Seul Walleye Cup and its promotion of the sport of fishing and the many public boat launches within the area;

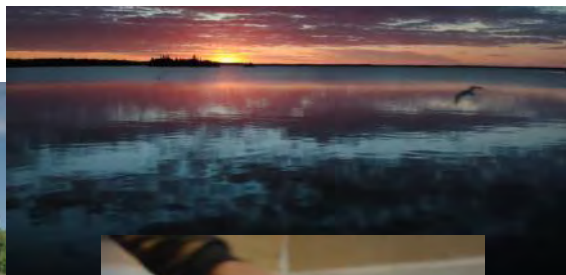
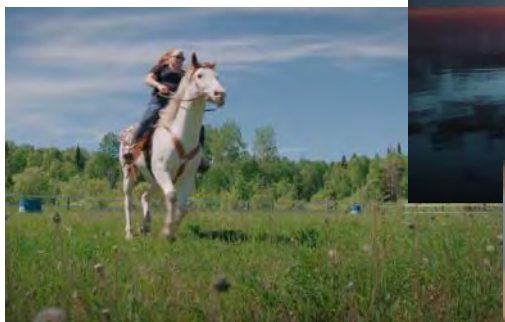
Ear Falls Winterfest & the Fall Festival which bring together the community with amazing indoor & outdoor seasonal activities;

Ear Falls Trivia

The beginning of the 17th century marked the arrival of French explorers to Northwestern Ontario and the beginning of the fur trade, **with trapper's still operating lines to this day;**

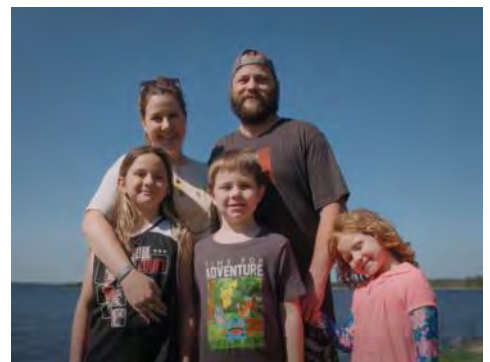
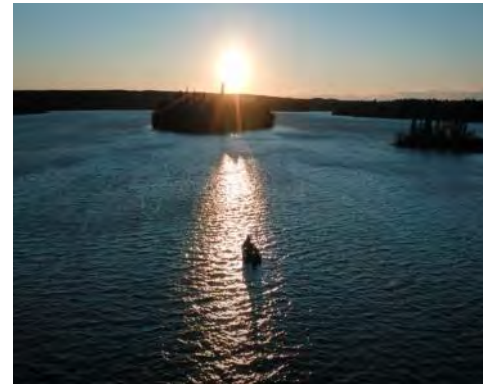
By 1923, the Canadian National Railway ran through the area, opening up the development of timber, fish, and mineral resources;

The construction of the dam at Ear Falls began in 1928, drowning out Upper Ear Falls. In order to retain operators for the dam, in 1937 Ontario Hydro constructed a colony at Ear Falls which became the base for our present community;

The construction of Highway 105 helped introduce tourism to the area, with hunting and fishing camps built on lakeshore sites along the highway. This industry still thrives in Ear Falls today;

Ear Falls was once known as Otahwaka Powitek to the Ojibwa people, believed to be haunted by the spirit of a giant beaver, with ears which could be seen rising & falling in the foaming water.

There have been two Hudson's Bay Posts in the area: one from 1825 to 1925 at Post Narrows, and one from 1925 to 1933 at Johnson's Point.

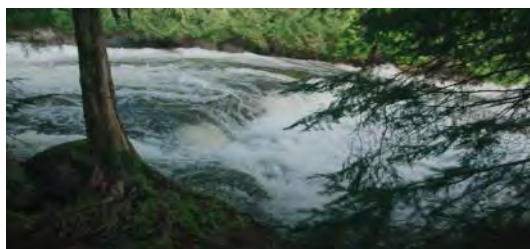

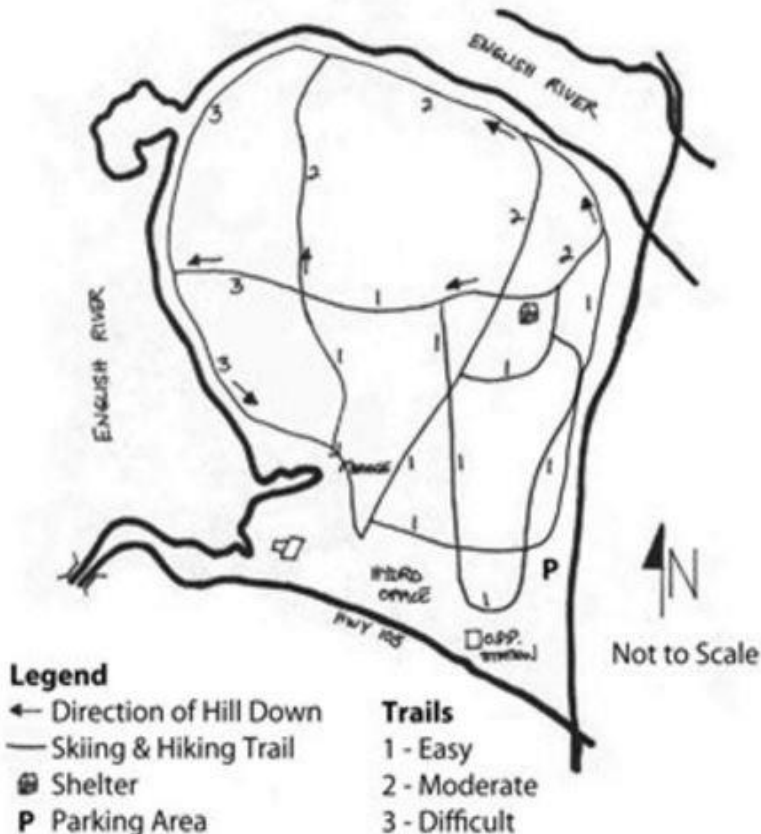

Dental and Medical

Ear Falls is well serviced by a variety of Primary Health Services. The Family Health Team, Health Unit and the Hospital (located a short drive from Ear Falls) are able to respond to all basic health care needs and immediate concerns here in the community. If specialist services are required, patients are referred to larger centres and, in most cases, travel grants are provided. Some specialists do service the community periodically.

Air Medivac is used to respond to medical emergencies that cannot be addressed locally. Telehealth is a free and confidential phone service you can call to get health advice from a Registered Nurse.

DENTAL SERVICES
