Pakwash Provincial Park, its scenic shores and its secluded camp sites;


The Norseman Floatplane Festival and the **Trout Forest Music Festival** and the fun and entertainment they bring to the community;

RED LAKE TRIVIA

- **1925, July 25** – The Howey Brothers strike gold, forever changing the future of Red Lake.
- **By 1930**, mining was in full swing - and even today, exploration continues to reveal new opportunities.
- **1936** – Believe it or not, Howey Bay was once the *busiest airport in the world!*
- Drive as far north as Ontario's Provincial Highway System will take you, and you'll arrive at the **ferry dock in Cochenour**.
- Red Lake held the title of **Norseman Floatplane Capital of the World**, a nod to its aviation legacy.
- The Hudson's Bay Company left its mark here too, with **two trading posts: Post Narrows (1825–1925) and Johnson's Point (1925–1933)**

Is there a dog park in Red Lake? The fenced dog park is located at the Buffalo Street turnaround with areas for both large and small dogs.


Where can I buy pet food? Buford & Figgy's Place located at 10 - Fifth Street, Balmertown carries pet food & supplies.
